



KING'S CORONATION FUNDING

Scottish Borders Council is providing a one-off payment of up to £500 to each community council to host celebratory events over the weekend to help promote inclusion, wellness and tackle social isolation. The grant can be used for a variety of purposes including:

- Hire of venues and equipment
- Purchase of food and drink (non-alcoholic)
- Purchase of sundries
- Marketing costs
- Public Liability Insurance

SBC have made a commitment towards becoming more sustainable and reducing emissions over several years to go plastic-free where possible within your project, and particularly when sourcing items such as plates, cutlery, and napkins etc. for your Coronation celebration. If you are serving food, please think about how you will deal with any leftover stock to reduce food waste.

The grant cannot pay for:

- Alcohol
- Salaries & wages e.g. street entertainer, band, catering staff etc. A small donation could be made to an organisation providing such a service.
- Commemorative items such as medals, benches, trees, and gifts

Events must be free, accessible, and open to everyone in your community.

You will need to keep any receipts, proof of payments, and complete an evaluation form after the event.

If you are hosting an event meeting the criteria, please let Newcastleton Community Council know so we can apply for the sum on your behalf.
