You may already be aware, but Scottish Borders Council currently has an active Citizen Space survey on footway parking, which can be accessed via the link provided below;

Under the Transport (Scotland) Act 2019, parking on all pavements/footways will be prohibited with the exception of specific areas identified by local authorities that meet certain requirements. Further information on the Act is available on the following link;
