For anyone unfamiliar with Unpaid Work, it is work carried out, free of charge and for the benefit of the community and/ or the people within these communities. Work could be grass gutting, a garden tidy up, painting fences, clearing paths, cleaning road signage, building planters/ benches, picnic tables, litter picking, gritting paths in poor weather conditions, the list is endless. Or, more tailored work could be considered if you have a specific task/ job/ projects in mind. All we ask is that materials are provided, however quotes can be made available if so required. Those undertaking the work will be subject to a Community Payback Order as imposed by the relevant Court and as part of a community sentence and reparation.
